

AMENDMENT TO H.R. 5896
OFFERED BY MR. HURD OF TEXAS

Page 6, line 7, strike “(V)” and insert “(IV)”.

Page 15, line 7, strike “(i)” and insert “(h)”.

Page 17, line 2, strike the quotation marks and the second period.

Page 17, after line 2, insert the following:

1 “(4) SUNDAY PAY; PREMIUM PAY.—A border
2 patrol agent assigned to an alternative work sched-
3 ule under this subsection, may receive, as applica-
4 ble—

5 “(A) Sunday pay for no more than 8 hours
6 of regular time associated with a given Sunday,
7 consistent with section 5546(a);

8 “(B) premium pay for work on a holiday
9 for no more than 8 hours of regular time asso-
10 ciated with a given holiday, consistent with sec-
11 tion 5546(b); and

12 “(C) basic pay for all regular time hours
13 that qualify for holiday time off pay when an
14 agent is relieved or prevented from working
15 during such regular time on a day designated

1 as a holiday by Federal statute or Executive
2 order.

3 “(5) APPLICATION.—For purposes of admin-
4 istering sections 6303(a), 6304, 6307(a) and (d),
5 6323, 6326, 6327, and 8339(m), in the case of an
6 employee assigned to an alternative work schedule
7 under this subsection, references to a day or work-
8 day (or to multiples or parts thereof) contained in
9 such sections shall be considered to be references to
10 8 hours (or to the respective multiples or parts
11 thereof).

12 “(i) REGULATIONS.—The Director of the Office of
13 Personnel Management shall promulgate regulations to
14 carry out this section, including regulations governing—

15 “(1) elections and assignments of a border pa-
16 trol rate of pay for newly hired border patrol agents
17 who complete initial training during an annual pe-
18 riod;

19 “(2) situations in which an agent receives more
20 than one type of border patrol rate of pay in a bi-
21 weekly pay period or is employed as a border patrol
22 agent for only part of a biweekly pay period; and

23 “(3) the treatment of hours that are substituted
24 for nonpay status hours during regular time.”.

Page 17, strike lines 3 through 18.
